Teachers have been trained in Trust-Based Relational Intervention (TBRI) and focus on teaching students self-regulation strategies and how to build strong relationships. We also offer special services and support for students with disabilities.

Under current USDA waivers, all complete student meals are free of charge. Additional entrees or a la carte items are an additional cost, charging is not allowed on these items, students must have sufficient funds to purchase.
